 Annual Pancake Breakfast**

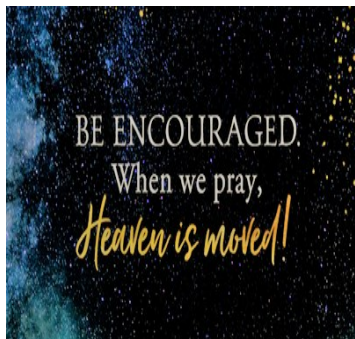
