

#### SPIRITUAL GROWTH AND EDUCATION

This area includes but it not limited to the Christian formation and education of our children, youth and adults of our membership and beyond. Nurturing faith, building Christian community, discipleship, equipping all for ministry in daily life is an important responsibility and an area to be taken very seriously. Sunday School, Adult Study, Confirmation, Camping, VBS, Youth Fellowship and Bible Study, Lay Speaking, small groups and other opportunities are included in this area.

Our budget allows \$32,514.00 per year for this area.

#### MISSION AND OUTREACH

Along with Spiritual Growth and Education, Mission and Outreach is another important ministry. This area includes all the ways we try to reach out as a church. Whether it be direct service as in mission trips, service projects, food shelf support, community involvement, or as simple as encouraging Sunday service attendance, Bible Study and visitors to church. Reaching out and sharing the love of Christ with our neighbors, our community and beyond is an important area of focus and concentration.

Our budget allows \$41,128.00 per year for this area.

#### **NURTURE AND MINISTRY**

This area includes, but is not limited to the care and concern of our members, friends and community. Our church is committed to being available in whatever way is necessary to share the love of Christ. We do this through our Prayer Ministry, visiting our shut ins, those in nursing homes, and what other needs may present themselves at any given time.

Our budget allows \$22,029.00 per year for this area.

#### **WORSHIP**

The costs and expense in this area include those things necessary to carry out worship services within the church. These costs include, but are not limited to congregational supplies, paper supplies, regular and special services, music and other such enhancements, technology, decorations, candles, flowers, communion supplies, etc.

Our budget allows \$31,490.00 for this area.

#### PROPERTY AND MAINTENANCE

This area pertains to all matters of care and maintenance of buildings, grounds, parsonage and other facilities belonging to the church, as well as utilities and insurance. Trustees are the main caretakers of all properties and such.

\*Our budget allows \$46,854.00 for this area.\*
Figures for updating our Heating and Cooling have not been included in this figure.

#### **ADMINISTRATION**

The Administration area of the church provides for planning, implementation and organization of the local church and its functions. It involves all aspects of business and structure which includes any office duties, official paperwork and letter writing, membership care, handling correspondence, charge conference prep and care, table reports, calendar and scheduling, assisting other ministry areas, meeting and planning, communication and other needs which arise in the administrative care of this charge.

Our budget allows \$41,902.00 for this area.

This is preliminary for 2019. A detailed, line by line, traditional breakdown of the 2019 budget will be available from the church office upon request after January 1, 2019.
