Easter Greetings to all of you....

By the time you read this, you may very well have celebrated the Risen Christ at our Easter Service, maybe even picked up the last of the Easter basket grass and finished off the egg salad from all the boiled eggs. Easter is a special time in our Christian lives, one that calls us to celebrate and embrace our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ as he breaks the stronghold of death and makes eternal life for us a reality. He is Risen, He is Risen Indeed!

One of the most special stories I have found in the Bible is the story of the two men walking on the road to Emmaus after all the events of Holy Week in Jerusalem. They talked seriously of what they had seen, offering thoughts and opinions to each other when a man appeared asking them what events they were speaking of...they didn't recognize him. As they continued along, the men shared with (Jesus) about the arrest, death, and resurrection of the man they called Jesus. (Jesus) then offered depth to the meaning of those events.

Once they got to the village where the men lived, they tried to coax the man to join them for dinner, to which he agreed.... while there (Jesus) took bread, blessed it, and broke it and gave it to them. It was then that their eyes were opened to whom was sitting with them. After that, his presence left their home.

And then my favorite part, "Were not our hearts burning within us while he was talking with us on the road?"

While we walked through Holy Week, the events reminded us just how deep the love Jesus has for us. Jesus endured until his death and then came back to life to give us life!

As we journey through our own lives, Jesus walks along side of us, sometimes giving only a hint that he is there, but still making his presence known to us. In this story, you will notice how the men eventually invited Jesus into their home, indicating an interest to know more, to be closer, to have time and it was then when Jesus truly revealed himself to them. They then realized that they had felt him from the moment Jesus joined them on the road.

That's how Jesus loves us.... always there, not imposing on us, waiting for an invitation. Embrace, if even for a moment, the idea that Jesus indeed walks along our journey.... anticipating a moment when you might invite him in and get to know him more deeply. The entirety of his life was for you.... because God loves you that much! This Easter Season is a celebration of life, and a celebration of all that Jesus did, We should break bread, invite him into your heart and discover a life of love and guidance!

Various Members of our Church recently meant to discuss areas of finance in our church to avoid the end of year scramble we have every year to meet our budget. We discussed many aspects of how that happens, and ideas were shared to try to change this experience and improve our financial health. We offered several things we could do:

- *Use the Fifth Sunday to address various areas of need in our church, making a specific request with colored envelopes that month.
- * Develop a detailed pamphlet detailing various areas of our finances and how they support our church and those within and beyond. Offering specific areas members may support.
- *Be more visual in the areas of our church which members may not realize the impact of our budget. IE: we have 15 bathrooms, what does it take to care of them?
- *Bring in people to share specific information about our monthly Silver Bucket
- *Be purposeful in offering opportunities for giving, including the opportunity for more to sign up for electronic giving. We will work on providing time for individually sharing information and signing up on Sundays for a period of time.
